Restoration Of The Bride Tree #13

Prophet To Gentiles; Capstone Pointing--Immortality February 06, 1994 #0794

Let us pray.

Heavenly Father, we're very glad that You've given us the privilege of prayer, even the commandment, and to pray without ceasing, to pray over all things, and Lord, we do pray for this service, the Word that we teach from what Brother Branham taught Lord,

knowing that he was vindicated of You, that You spoke to him, and he spoke to You and the answer always came back in that perfection which only could come back under anointed prophet like Moses or Paul.

We appreciate that today and we just ask You Lord, to solemnise our hearts as never before to receive what has been spoken to us and been proven to be true, where so much and so many years of messages and sermons have not been proven to be true but rather in the light of the hour have been proven to be way, way,

far removed from the reality of Your Word, even as when the time when Jesus Himself came upon earth and the revelation of truth was so far removed from what they thought and stood for that they crucified the Lord of glory.

And we know at the end time people will do the same thing, crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh. We recognise that Lord, and we thank You that You help us that we will not be found in that number, in Jesus' Name, we pray,

Amen.

You may be seated.

01 Now we're on number 13 of The Restoration of the Bride Tree as brought by Brother Branham. And we're going to catch up from last night to go on today. Now, last night we saw Brother Branham trace the restoration of the Bride Tree or which is the Bride of Christ or also, it's called the true church, the church of the Living God, the body of Christ:

there's various appellations. And so Brother Branham traced it through the Reformation of the three steps of Luther, Wesley and Pentecostals which three brought Justification, Sanctification, the Baptism with the Holy Ghost, the restoration of gifts, of course,

which when completed at the last days of Pentecostalism brings us to restoration. Restoration according to Acts 3 is just exactly prior to the literal descent of the Lord Jesus Christ Himself meeting the Bride at the Wedding Supper. 02 Now what Brother Branham is teaching here of the three steps of Justification, Sanctification, Baptism with the Holy Ghost, leading us to this restoration can easily be understood from the Book of Acts, chapter 2:38-39 where it says,



Acts 3:38

(38) Repent, and be baptised every one of you in the name of [the Lord] Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and [you] shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Now, you take that instantly to the 1st chapter of Ephesians and you'll find out what the Baptism with the Holy Ghost leads you to. And it says,



Ephesians 1:13-14

- (13) In whom [you] trusted, after [you] heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom... after that [you] believed, [you receive what the] holy Spirit of promise,
- (14) Which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, [to] the praise of his glory.

So you see right here, that the Baptism with the Holy Ghost actually leads you right to the Resurrection. And before the Resurrection there is a restoration. So, we say then easily understood these three steps, preceding restoration because once you have repented and been justified by grace and baptised in water and filled with the Holy Ghost you are face to face with the Resurrection and the kingdom of God on earth.

03 Now listen, the Resurrection brings you physically into the Presence of God who Himself becomes physical to us. That's right. Because once you're baptised with the Holy Ghost the next step, even though there are years in between, that makes no difference, you are told right here, you have the earnest of the Resurrection.

And in that Resurrection you will be physical and you will meet God physically once more, the same as He was met on earth.

Now, this... now there, is a great gap rather, there is a gap at the end time where the last few members of the Bride Tree, or the body of Jesus Christ, the true church, the church of God, call It what you want, do not die and face the Resurrection and then God in flesh,

but must come to a place of restoration which point is where Adam was with God who was in spirit form, God was, He wasn't in the form of a man, and Adam was physical, and where Adam could get to the Tree of Life and immortality but he was stopped.

04 Now you've got to come to that place because you're dealing with Adam as a living person, going to the Tree of Life for immortality, the Cherubim because of God says, "No, you cannot do that. Lest you live in that condition you are in eternally and you cannot do it."

So there was a great interruption. Now, what I'm trying to show you, Alpha is Omega and you cannot deny that reality. He had to get to that Tree of Life. We know Christ is that Tree of Life.

God Himself is the only Living God and Adam was cut off from getting there, the Cherubim would not allow him to go. So all right, we are now at the place where that is restored, there's going to be so few living people, not many, maybe five hundred, a thousand, or something,

I don't know. But it's going to be like the days of Noah, very few are going to be standing here in their own human bodies, right, restored to that place where they can now come into immortality.

05 Now listen, what happened to Adam and Eve? They went off the Word. The obedience of faith off the Word was gone; had they stayed there they could have stayed there thousands and thousands of years. So we must get back to that; there has to be a restoration. Now you can see this is logical from Scripture.

It's not only THUS SAITH THE LORD by a prophet who was vindicated, like Moses and Paul, which he was and anybody to deny that will have to destroy history. They'd have to kill me, too, because they're not going to get away with it. There has to come that restoration back to that Word. See? To come into immortality.

06 Now, this simply cannot under any circumstances come to pass until the Bride Tree, or we're referring to the Tree because Paul said, "You are God's husbandry. You're God's agriculture. You're God's plot of ground and He's growing out of you, what He has planted, sown and seeded in you."

So, this simply cannot under any circumstances come to pass until the Tree, Bride Tree puts out Its last branch. Now, there's... the Word of God speaks of and... I'll come back to my notes and I'll read it for you again, but you'll want to get it right here in the Book of Romans, the 11th chapter, now it says in verse 25.



Romans 11:25

(25) For I would not, brethren, that [you] should be ignorant of this mystery, lest ye be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fullness of the Gentile comes in.

That's... the church. The Gentile age is all over. Now it's not the times of the Gentiles, that's political and geographical. This is a hundred percent spiritual, and apart from politics and geography. This is a mystery.

07 Now the last one as Irenaeus said, "Christ cannot come until the last member elected member to the body of Christ comes in." and Brother Branham added correctly, *"child-trained."* You can't because it's in the adoption. And the adoption goes right into the Resurrection. Now if we're in that hour, these things have got to simply, got to happen. So, when you're going to call the Bride of Christ a Tree, you have to realise that there's going to come a time when the last branch is going to come upon It. There's not going to be anymore.

That's why you get the picture of the vine. The branches that are dead, the churches that have left the life of Christ and Christ has gone on because they haven't gone on with the Light, they're pruned and they're taken away.

It's the same thing that says, the wheat is separated from the chaff, and the chaff is burned and the boughs are burnt. It's all the same thing. But said in so many ways that it will strike the people that are in that particular category, that are interested in buildings, or agriculture, grazing of sheep, growing grapes, you name it, making wine, it doesn't matter. You'll find that same thing in there.

08 Now, it tells you then that the life of Christ in the baptism with the Holy Ghost has to run out at a certain time and it's when it runs out. And it tells you right here in Ephesians,



Ephesians 1:17

- (17) [At that time] the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, [the Lord of glory,] the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:
- 09 The church receives the fullness of the Spirit of Almighty God and see where it takes us. It takes us to the mighty working of the power of God in verse 19, which raised him from the dead. It puts you right into the Resurrection; it tells you there's a gap in here.

When the baptism with the Holy Ghost runs out, it means the last elected member has been baptised into the body of the Lord Jesus Christ and that's exactly what I told you happened in the Book of Acts, which is the 3rd chapter.

And in the 3rd chapter, we're looking at where Peter is preaching and he said to the Jews,



Acts 3:19-21

- (19) Repent... therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out,[then he says,] when times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; [And that absolutely is a revival sent from God and it's a healing revival.]
- (20) And he shall send Jesus Christ, which [was appointed] unto you:
- (21) Whom the heaven[s] must receive until the... [restoration] of all things, which God [has] spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

He tells you right there, that there is going to be a great... there is going to be this last day revival, which Brother Branham truly indicated and showed us was a healing revival.

And with it will come a message of the Word re-given. The same Message that Paul

brought, is going to be absolutely verified as to its correct revelation; it has to be. That's 2 Thessalonians, the 1st chapter, verses 7 to 10. You can't deny the Bible.

10 There's a gap in here and that gap is where there's restoration and the Presence of God Himself is there to bring it. And you cannot deny it. There's no way "for the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout."

And that word 'shout' is the same word 'kalusma'. It's the same word in 1 Corinthians 15, that puts you under command. God Himself comes down and puts his church under his own authority, away from denomination, priests and popes and presidents and everything else.

"Why," you say, "I don't believe that." You don't have to believe anything. But just show me one reason why you don't believe it, pitted against a man who was vindicated.

Listen, I was in his meetings dozens of times, never one time did THUS SAITH THE LORD ever fail, never one time. Show me anybody that's got that record, show me a man vindicated; went back to the Word every single time.

I'm going on eighty years of age, I've lived seventy-nine already and I know whereof I speak, I've read the books, I know the history, I've forgotten more perhaps than some of you folk will every know along this line, that's not just boasting.

I've read many, many books on theology. Great men of God, not that they were wrong, they were right for their day but at the end time there has to come this restoration of the Word.

11 Billy Graham sat on the aeroplane with Ned Iverson, Ned Iverson's dad, Dr. Dan Iverson wrote, 'Spirit of the Living God, fall afresh on me', which brought a revival. He struck up a conversation with Billy Graham which doesn't mean anything.

Who's Billy Graham? Doesn't mean a thing to me, except as a fine Christian brother, that's good. But... where's his authority? But he admitted, "The Word had not been restored." Say, what's he going to do about it?

Nothing, he's not required to do a thing about it. He's doing his own thing. He's doing his own job. He's doing a good job. Billy Graham's a fine man of God, well respected, and well loved; speaks out on issues that are very, very pertinent. See? And that's very good, so all right.

12 The Bride Tree, all right, Genesis, going back again, Adam is standing there. Now look when Adam is standing there, God is not in a physical form, He's in a Spirit form. And He comes down in the form of that Spirit, it could be the Pillar of Fire, it could be a cloud, it could be a rustling in the wind, I don't know.

But I do know God was not manifest in flesh that did not take place until the time of Jesus Christ, so God Himself did manifest Himself in the flesh of Melchisedec. And that's not something that God can't do, God can do anything He wants to do. But God literally manifested in human flesh was not in the Garden of Eden, it was way back there. 13 So all right, then the requirements of Alpha and Omega, the beginning what was sown must come to pass at the very end, the way it was. The interruption brings it up here. So what have you got? You've got Adam and God on earth, now we're talking about mankind, the ones that are Bride that are going to go that Tree and live forever.

God in the form of the Holy Spirit must be here now and that's what Ephesians said. And that's what it says here in the Book of Acts. Now that's not hard to understand, that's as simple as A-B-C, once you let your thinking go and begin to believe what you're taught by a vindicated man. All right.

14 Now this last growth, this last limb coming out, is the top that's the very top of the tree, right? Now watch carefully, the actual top of any tree unless you lop it off, you understand, the actual top of any tree is that original first shoot that came out of the root.

And it keeps moving up and moving up and moving up, naturally it would. I've got trees in my yard and... they're... blue spruce, Colorado blue spruce, and you better believe that there has not been one limb lopped off of those trees. And we have different ones in the yard.

And every one that was that little shoot is now that top. And one day there's going to be a time when that tree will not grow one more inch, it's over. And it will either live for ever or it's going to die. Something has got to happen.

15 Now that's where we find the church today. Remember, in Daniel's vision, it was from the head down, the head of gold down to feet. Now it's from feet up to the head. And this is what you find in the Book of Ephesians,

how God sent the Holy Spirit with the Holy Spirit ministry in order to build an edifice which went right up unto Christ, to a Capstone. Now remember, the Cornerstone was put at naught and the Cornerstone becomes the Capstone, because Christ is the Cornerstone and Christ is the Capstone.

And you take that Cornerstone and it will fit right on top of the pyramid. So therefore, again the principle of Alpha and Omega is correct. I am Alpha and Omega. You cannot tell God anything, you say, "Lord, I don't believe You're Alpha and Omega." That doesn't do one bit of good. He is Alpha and Omega, always was and never can change any time whatsoever. So, all right.

16 The actual top of any tree should be and in this case is the original shoot out of the ground. The original one of whom Paul spoke and said, "The foundation for the building I have laid is Jesus Christ the righteous," but the Bride is also called 'husbandry' not just the building.

And Brother Branham at the end time called it a 'tree'. So the church should have been one glorious display of God's fruit which was Christ. Because He was God's fruit, the Tree planted by the water that brought forth His fruit is God's Fruit.

And He brought forth the Word, complete Word of God in Christ, and God completely manifested Himself as to who and what He was in and through Jesus, so Jesus could say, "He that has seen Me has seen the Father."

And Jesus was not the Father, and Jesus was not God; he was the Son of God. People can't

get Godhead straight, I don't understand, I'm not going to fuss about it, I just give up.

I give up, they say brother, they say, "Lee Vayle, is teaching two gods." Well, I believe Brother Branham, you know that, I believe him implicitly. And if I'm teaching two gods, then listen to William Branham teaching two gods. A man we claim is vindicated.

A man we claim that's the actual picture of the Pillar of Fire, scientific. I don't care what anybody believes, we believe it. And we can show you the records, there's even a couple of films that extant. Oh, my God, I wish there'd been hundreds of films, but that wasn't God's doing.

17 Now listen, Brother Branham speaks of the original creation back there and he said,

ATTITUDE AND WHO IS GOD? 50-08-15

[E18] What's he doing? God is writing his first Bible. Notice, the human beings once looked toward the heavens. And He put all the stars in the heavens and the zodiac, starting off with the Virgin, ending up with Leo the Lion. First coming of Christ, second coming. Came by the Virgin, comes again as the 'Lion of the tribe of Judah. There He puts His Bible.

18 Everyone knows the twelve signs of the Zodiac, a Bible in the stars, same as the pyramid is the Bible in the rock. And you can read Boulanger and Size and various other authors and they will show you absolute biblical truths that are of no end, it's marvellous there.

[E19] Oh, back in the days of ancient days they looked at those things. Today He's got his Bible written here. But He wrote it in the heavens, that's the first, then the man could look up and realise Jehovah the Creator was above. And then I can see him, he looked at that.

[E20] *I can see the* end, I can see the seed of this world hanging there as an icicle, whatever it was anyway, and it moved way over there, *I can see this little light go out, now we've got two. The Father and out of the Father came the Light, the Son.*

Now God the Son isn't true; it's the Son of God. God is one being; He's Holy Spirit and when there wasn't a spark of stardust, there wasn't one atom, there was nothing, a Light formed. What could have formed out of it, except God? What does a baby form out of? Except the woman. You know it's so easy to think if you let your thinking go and you become so foolish with dogma and creedal misunderstanding that destroys every insight.

Now, Brother Branham says right here, and I concur a hundred percent because that's exactly what Paul said in the 1st chapter of Hebrews, anybody can read it. It's there. Two, one is God who becomes a Father and there's a Son. Do what you want about it. No problem with me. See?

19 Now, so the church should have been one glorious display of God's fruit which was Christ. But no, the organisation of creeds and dogmas ate it off. God's fruit the Word was put aside and finally outside the Church, that's Revelation 3.

So the church grew without this fruit and the bugs ate up all manifestation that belongs to the Fruit Tree and only bare life of God kept on past the dead branches which God pruned away. Now finally the Bride is about complete, it is time to return to the Tree of Life and immortality. So the Cornerstone, the first shoot of the Tree is now the Capstone and we see God's promise, I will restore, made manifest in the person of God Himself bringing forth the same fruits according to Matthew 12 as it was in Jesus on earth.

20 Now, I'll read this again, I've read it hundreds of times to you, but let's look at Matthew, the 12th chapter, and let's begin to understand some things here that have been glossed over, perhaps, hundreds maybe, no doubt, hundreds of years. Now it says in chapter... verse 15 of 12.



Matthew 12:15-18

- (15) But when Jesus knew it, he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;
- (16) And [he] charged them that they should not make him known:
- (17) That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying,
- (18) [Now listen!] Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgement to the Gentiles.

He didn't even go near the Gentiles, the closest he got was to a Samaritan woman. So all right, this can't be to the Jews. There's something in here indicative and predictive concerning him from Isaiah that has to do with the Gentiles.



Let's read further.



Matthew 12:19

(19) He shall not strive,

Hogwash! He strove. Is that a fact? Come on. Is that a fact? Let's understand it; he strove. He went to the temple and he braided out of ropes, whips, and he whipped the daylights out of them. He strove, so this is a lie. "Well, I just don't see it, Brother Vayle." Well, come on, open your eyes. It's in here; he's got to do it. He didn't strive. He strove.



Matthew 12:19-20

- (19) ...nor cry; [John 7:37-39 he raised his voice in the streets at the last feast, said, No man] shall hear his voice in the streets. [He was a street preacher.]
- (20) [The] bruised reed shall he not break, [He broke it.] [the] smoking flax he will not quench,

He quenched it. This is not to the Jews. He said the Gentile church started on that solid Rock will endure to the end and God will come forth and in judgement give her victory; right to the Tree of Life. How anybody can doubt that is more than I know.

22 "At the end time Christ is now revealed in His own Word and proven by vindication." I'm quoting from William Branham, a vindicated man. Until people... he went off the scene, and people began to hate him and fuss about everything he said, they admitted, his ministry was a duplication of the ministry of Jesus Christ.

It wasn't his ministry anymore than it was Jesus' ministry. Jesus said, "The miracles that are doing, the things that I'm doing, I'm not doing it.

What I'm telling you, it's not my words. You know your Bibles." That's what he said, and let's go a little further, Jesus wasn't God, he was a prophet and a Son of God. Yes.

And the Psalmist said, "He called them gods to whom the Word of God comes," and who does the Word of God come to? But a prophet.

23 I came through an age of dithering; reading everybody under high heaven, but no man was vindicated till this man. When I saw everybody in a prayer line of about maybe a thousand, everyone was healed, there wasn't one deaf that didn't hear, one dumb that didn't speak, one blind eye that didn't open and see, and one crippled back and twisted legs that wasn't made straight: healed them all: I saw it, I'm a Gentile.

And I knew if I listened to any man I'd listen to that man and I've listened and if he's condemned, I'm condemned with him. If he's going to the lake of fire; I'm happy to go to the lake of fire. Because I'll tell you why; where I will be going to the lake of fire it will be million times better than those who think they know something and they merely prate the words of some man and there's no vindication. Nothing vindicated.

24 All right, let's read.

[72-4] The Tree grows from one place or one level to another, from one dispensation to another. From Luther It went to Wesley; from Wesley to Pentecost; Pentecost It goes to the Word.

Now why does he say that? It tells you right in that Fourth Church Age, if the Catholic church who has Jezebel, a prophetess, she's a harlot and the mother of harlots.

If she does not repent which means to change her mind concerning God and her understanding; she and her daughters go to the Tribulation and the lake of fire, but out of that comes the life of Luther, Justification: but the Catholic Church wouldn't listen.

Where is it today? Look at it. Look at their fruit: homosexual priests. Why? Because they deny them the natural function of a man: they went ahead of the Word of God.

Jesus himself said, "Celibacy is not for all men." Then why does the Catholic church say, "I can ordain every priest and he will be celibate." Hogwash! Well, come on. I'm not... going... chucking this for the Protestants; I'm no longer a Protestant. I'm just a Christian. The Protestants have no more protest than a... you know, than... the weight of a cigarette paper

and I think they're out of style, too.

[72-4] From Luther It went to Wesley; Wesley to Pentecost; Pentecost It goes to the Word.

It's the only place it can go. The only place it can go because the Lord Himself descends with that Shout, that Kalusma, which is distinctly a message to the church where the church becomes subject to Him, because the word 'kalusma' means 'subjection'. And it's not coercion. No. We're back where Adam was.

25 Now, we're back to a degree, led by the Word, the way Adam was.

[72-5] It's Easter again for the true believers of His never failing Word.

Hundreds of thousands of Christians say the same thing. They don't say it the way we say it. They know there's something stirring in the air. They know there's a truth, but they fail to realise that Elijah must come to the Gentiles.

Do you realise that when Jesus talked about his Resurrection, he positively identified himself with a prophet that went to the Gentiles? Jonah. And now... you got it being fulfilled in the last day. Alpha and Omega is the same; you have a prophet to the Gentiles.

[72-5] It's Easter; it's... resurrection. God's got people everywhere. It's Easter for them. Why? They have risen [Amen!], risen from their creeds and denominations. Come right up through them. It's Easter again. [Or it's Resurrection time.]

The Royal Seed has been hid in the Roots, the Word, back here in this Word for years, and years, and years, [Actually almost two thousand.]and just now begin to be revealed. It's Easter time. Predestinated from the foundation of the world, this Church is beginning to stand.

26 Now, already you know that's Matthew 12, we read it awhile ago and already you know it's over here again in 2 Corinthians, the 2nd chapter, 11th chapter, I beg your pardon, we've read this hundreds of times, I make no apology for reading it a hundred times more if it's necessary and Paul said...



Matthew 12:2-4

- (02) ...I am jealous over you with [a] godly jealousy: I have espoused you to one husband, I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ.
- (03) But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.
- (04) [Now listen!]For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, [And they did,] whom we have not preached, or if [you] receive another spirit, [Which they did,] which ye have not received, or another gospel... [and they did it.]

Three strikes and you're out. Isn't there a show called "Three strikes and you're out now?" I think I read that. Everything shows what's going on in the world; you can't find even one

slang, catchy phrase anymore, that doesn't indicate it's all wrapped up and all over.

How far off can you get with another Jesus, another spirit, and another word? Tell me! If it started two thousand years ago, where is it today? You say, "Well, bless God, I can read that."

They read it back there and they read it better. Oh yeah, oh yeah and they read it better. And they knew more. And even back in the first age they had a split church over a diphthong, which means 'two vowels in the Greek with a different sound'. Oh yeah.

Because the Greek isn't punctuated, it goes by rhythm, and the kids at school are taught to accent the words and that's how you punctuate. There's no upper and lower case.

27 Well, hallelujah, we're different. Two thousand years later from the original? How many of you this morning drove to this church here in a 1927 Ford? Raise your hand. No? You're not that interested in relics and antiques, you want a car that moves. I'd like to trade my car in too, for one that moves a little better too.

I'm happy to trade my religion in for something that God vindicates and God is behind. Oh yes, when you hear a man say, *"THUS SAITH THE LORD your husband is in the hospital in New York. He's a veteran.*

They don't know a thing wrong with him but THUS SAITH THE LORD, tomorrow he'll be sitting in this chair, healed." And he was right there the next day sitting in that chair, healed. How did he know who did it? Come on. I saw that time after time. Yes.

I'm not talking about the healing now; I'm talking about THUS SAITH THE LORD. No man can come in the Name of the Lord, and God back him and him not be God's prophet just like Moses. Come on, read your Bibles.

Read your Bibles, I challenge you. Get with the Word of God. I feel real good now, if I was back in Pentecost; I'd be screaming and running right now. I'd be honest to God with you; I'm not lying. I couldn't contain myself, I'd be crying and screaming, reality strikes!

It's not merely an emotion that someone sits with his Bible and gets himself so full with his own thinking that something explodes within him, that will never bring THUS SAITH THE LORD and see the power of miracles and a vindication that God gave Moses and God gave Paul. Nobody can doubt Paul was vindicated. William Branham was vindicated.

28 [Paragraph 72-5]

[72-5] The Royal Seed has been hid in the Roots, [That's what happened. Joel tells you,] the Word, hid back here in this Word for years, and years, and years, begun to be... begin to be revealed. It's Easter time. Predestinated from the foundation of the world, this Church is beginning to stand.

[72-6] Notice, how God predestinated in the beginning. I'm going to say it anyhow.

Why does he say, *"I'm going to say it anyhow?"* Because the Pentecostals hated the word 'predestinated'; they can't stand it. Everything is free-will, free-will, free-will; I can come to

God, I can pass that, I can go to hell, I can come back to God, oh, hallelujah, escape from hell, oh, I backslid, back to hell.

Oh, forget it. When did God ever have yo-yo Christians? Come on. They hated the word 'predestination' so he said, "Well, I'll use the word 'foreknowledge'" and they grinned.

29 Well, you know you hate the word 'cancer' so they go to the doctor and the doctor knows you hate the word 'cancer' and he said, "Well, you have a little polyp." Wonderful! Huh? Predestination is the word, it means there was a foreknown destiny and that thing is right there the way God said it.

God knew under that seat I usually sit in, there would be for years a great big thick Concordance and a notebook and some pencils and a box in case I leave my pens at home and colored pens to underline what suddenly comes to my mind.

He knew it. He didn't just know it because I put it there. He knew I was going to put it there. He knew Pharaoh was going to kill those children. You know why he could judge Pharaoh; Pharaoh didn't have to do it. God knew he was going to do it. It was ordained.

30 All right he says here,

[72-6] Notice here, to restore the perfect fruit the perfect Tree in three days after His death.

Now he's talking about Jesus, the perfect Tree of God, the perfect fruit of God, the perfect manifestation of God because that's exactly true, because he said, "What you see me do; it's my Father in me. What you're hearing me say; it's my Father talking in me.

What more could you want?" You know that would be fantastic; wouldn't it? What a marvellous man Jesus was.

[72-6] After the first Tree's death, He restored It in three days.

Now we're going back to Alpha, to Omega to this day, we're hitting the type. We're hitting like in this... Jesus is now become type and we're getting anti-type on this particular thought. Now just don't be confused by my words; I've tried to choose them very carefully. This is really in a type.

[72-6] After the first Tree, [That's Jesus' death.] God restored It in three days. Is that right? Restored it back. [And who was He? He was the Word. Right?] Now, the Bride Tree is also going to be restored in three stages, Three stages It'll be restored. Now look! What? Justification, Sanctification, Baptism with the Holy Ghost, one, two, three.

31 [73-1] Now notice, after three days the first Tree restored as at the beginning, having the same signs, same wonders. Jesus came back, the same Jesus, doing the same things.

How do you know He did? In the Resurrection he was on the seashore there and they had loaves and fishes; he just... created them. And in his Resurrection he sat down and ate a fish sandwich with his boys, with his friends. "Well, I don't think I like that thought of that kind of a Millennium with that kind of a Resurrection." Who asked you to think anything? If I invite you to my supper table, do I send you an invitation and say I'll cook a special meal for you, I've already cooked a special meal for you, come and take it. Simple as A-B-C.

[73-1] ...after three days... At the end of the third day the signs appeared, not at the end of the first day. [Notice, even on the road to Emmaus; what happened?] Oh, brother, I hope you're getting it. At the third... at the third day is when the real manifestation of Christ was made known, at the end of the third day!

32 Now what is he talking about? Jesus was absolutely the Son of God or God would not have raised Him. And there He was, the Bible says, in a different form. And they recognised Him, not by what He looked like but what He was doing.

For they saw the man on the shore and he said, "Have you caught any fish? Do you have any meat?"

They said, "No, we've toiled all night."

He said, "Throw the net on the other side."

The minute they threw it, listen, how wide is a boat, as Dr. Price once said? This pulpit could be the boat they're fishing in. How wide? How wide from here where there's no fish, to here where there's multitudes of fish?

They pulled in the net, it was almost breaking and Peter said, "That's Jesus." By what he did: by what he did. "Yeah." God in the man, God doing it, He did it, He had to do it all the time.

33 [73-2] Now at the first day, dead form; second day still dead, Luther, Wesley. In the beginning of the third day there was a rumour around. [You know what that rumour was? Of course, it was Pentecostal rumour. Let's keep reading.] Nothing on the first day Luther, nothing on the second day, and in the third day [the dispensation of the Holy Spirit] there was a rumour around that He was the same yesterday, today, and forever.

That came out of Pentecost with their gifts of healing; not real gifts of healing, just healing. I don't believe they had gifts of healing back there. But what I saw in Brother Branham and Dr. Price and various men of that calibre; it was my understanding Brother Branham alone had a true gift of healing.

I saw things that stood before Dr. Price and stood and stood and stood; but when the gift of healing went into operation and I saw it in Lima, Ohio and I saw it elsewhere, nothing stood, every miracle, bang, just one, two, three, four, five, six, seven, eight, nine, ten, fifty miracles in fifty minutes.

I never saw that in any other person. And I am a person of the twentieth century. You have your Wigglesworth is and your Roberts, and you have your Prices and you, well, let's not worry about Sister McPherson because she's kind of a no-no in my books. You know, women preachers. I just leave them alone and pray they'll leave me alone. 34 Now listen, let me tell you something here. Hebrews 13:8, according to fundamental people is always the acts and the manifestation coming into order that shows them He's the same yesterday, today and forever.

Brother Branham did not say that. Vindicated prophet now, let's get this, he said, "It was chapter 18 of the book of Genesis where God in a human form, which He was, with two angels, also in human form, stood outside the tent and Sarah in the tent, and God stood with Abraham, just before the burning of Sodom and Gomorrah, and He with His back to the tent said, "Sarah is going to have a child by you, this is the time." And Sarah said, "Ha, ha, ha.

Shall I and my lord have pleasure, physical pleasure of sex again, we've had it for years and years; will we get it back and that's the end of it. She no more believed for a baby than nothing. And God said, "Sarah, why did you laugh?" she said, "Oh, but I didn't laugh." She was laughing inside, you see, a little joke to herself. He said, "Oh, but you did laugh."

And Brother Branham stood there before thousands, I saw him time after time, turn his back to the thousands of people and said, "There's a man out there." called him by name. The man said, "You, your name is Mitchell, you're from West Virginia, you are a miner, you have lung disease, black lung, THUS SAITH THE LORD you're healed."

35 In Kansas, a black man sat in the audience; he was backslidden, Brother Branham looked down upon that man, he said, *"Sir,"* he said, *"you are a Christian, but you are not living in victory."*

The man said, "That's right."

He said also, "You're very, very sick."

He said, "That's right."

He told him what it was; and he said, "You are healed." And he said, "Furthermore you are forgiven." And a ripple went through the congregation, he said, "I caught that." He said, "You're saying, 'how can I a man say the man is forgiven. Let me tell you this, the same One that told me what his name was, what his disease was, told him he was healed, is the same One that told me he was forgiven."

Oh, we can be so self-righteous all of a sudden because we don't have the first fruit. We want to stick to some church. What is your church going to do? If it follows you to the end, it will bury you nicely, say nice words, even though you might not be worthy of them.

I don't mean to smile and get a joke out of this but the fact of the matter is I wonder if I didn't preach some people into heaven at their funeral. I wonder. I don't anymore. I steer away from the subject and tell them how you can get there.

36 ^[73-2] ...there was a rumour...

The Pentecostals thought the restoration of gifts was the restoration spoken of by a... by the prophet Joel and also by Malachi, and also by Jesus: it was a restoration of gifts and the people that believe in the Elijah ministry also teach the restoration of manifestation of gifts.

They said, "That is restoration," but it's not, it's merely restoration of gifts. Why? Because you got to get back to the Word, because without the Word there aren't any gifts, period. Without the Word, there isn't a breath of fresh air, without the Word, there isn't a speck of stardust, there's not a speck of dust.

Without the Word; there's not Life. There is nothing without the Word. Because all things were made by the Word and all things are maintained by the Word. This is our understanding.

[73-2] But at the end of the third day, [that's at the end of Wesley, Luther, Pentecostal,] that is when He made Himself known. Came right down amongst them, came amongst His people and said, "Look at Me; I am that same One."

[73-3] The dead forms went on till they got to Pentecost, then began a rumour around that He was. Now, here in the last day here He is right with us, moving right amongst us.

37 And then people deny the very Word in the Bible that says, 'Presence', He is here and nobody saw Him come and nobody knew how He got here but He's here. That's what the word 'Presence' Parousia means.

[73-4] At the end of the third day, He appeared and showed all of them His resurrection sign, that He was living, the same yesterday, today, and forever, Living fruits of His Presence. Living fruit of His Presence [are you getting it?]

In other words, Brother Branham was telling the people: do you understand the same God that is working through me is that same One that was working through that man. That same Living God that was present in human flesh is now present amongst the Bride and manifesting Himself through human flesh which is a prophet.

Listen, if Paul wasn't a prophet and an apostle that started it, there's got to be one that finishes it, it can't help it, because Alpha is always Omega. The seed sown has to come back. What was sown in the first church to bring the first church?

The apostle prophet Paul It's got to come back to the very same and it isn't going to be Paul come back from the dead. I hope you understand principles and the Scripture, my brother, my sister, they are there. See?

[73-4] ...He appeared to them all, His Church. Why? They'd all got together. Amen! At the end of the third day.

38 The Bride is coming together.

[73-5] The evening Lights, the Bible said, would shine in the last day. The evening Light is the same Light in the West, that was the same Light that was in the East.

Now that's... how could we miss that? How could we miss it? There's only one sun; there's not three suns up there, four suns that have to do with our earth. There could be a million suns up there in the universe somewhere; who cares?

But the one that has to do with us if it ceased to shine we would all be frozen by morning, or within a few hours. If the sun went out; it's all gone, frozen stiff like an iceberg, or whatever.

39 The same Light; it shall be light at evening time and the light come, what other light can it be? There can't be another light, other than the original.

Now remember, the original life was God manifested in Christ. Paul received the revelation, the same life of God manifested through Paul, vindicated Paul, showing that he had the right to the Word. Who then is going to restore the Word?

It's going to have to be somebody that has the same testimony. And Paul said, "I want to charge you brethren and know this, what I am preaching you is not of man, I never learned it by myself, I never got it from myself, I never got it from seminaries.

I'm going to tell you flat, I was face to face with Him in the desert. I am bringing you His Word and I am vindicated by the miracles and signs and you know from Rome and Illyricum, all around it is known the ministry I have that vindicates me goes right back to Moses."

And Moses was vindicated. First of all God vindicated Himself to Moses. Moses at the burning bush was there, Moses could have said, "Well, you know, I better, I better high-tail it down the road. This is ridiculous." His curiosity was piqued. God knew just how to reach him.

And he said, "The bush is not burning. Marvellous!" And he stood there. And a voice said, "Moses, take your shoes off, you're on holy ground." God vindicated Himself to Moses. Then God vindicated Moses to the people and Moses vindicated had a vindicated Word. This is the Bible, brother/sister.

40 How do we get back to it? God's got to send a prophet and do what He always did. He can't change; the people said to God one day, to Moses, they said, "Moses, Moses, we can't stand this earth shaking. We can't stand the fire. We can't stand the thunder. We know God is there. Moses, please go up and tell God for us. Look, great God, deal with Moses, then send back Moses to deal with us."

God... Moses went up there, if you believe the Bible, if you don't believe the Bible, it's just a cute little story. You know, kind of nice. Crazy, but you know. So Moses goes up and God said, "Fine. They've well spoken what they've spoken.

I agree, go back and tell them. I'll never deal with them again outside of a prophet." Therefore, as Brother Branham said it and I never read it in any book, anywhere, and I've read my books. He said, *"You cannot worship and serve God outside of a prophet."* There it is, the prophet book. I'm satisfied.

41 What's going to restore the Word today? A prophet. It wasn't Joe Smith. It wasn't Mary Baker Eddy. It wasn't the council of ministers. God's got to send a prophet. You say, "What if the prophet comes and I miss him?" Just a minute, how many people caught on to Jesus?

How many people in Jerusalem stood there, at the... crucifixion and knew outside of a man

like the centurion, a Roman, a Gentile, who said, "This indeed is the Son of God." Everybody running and screaming and running off. When the seal was broken, the rock rolled away: how many believed?

It was only seen of about five hundred people when He came out of the ground and walked amongst them about forty days. Ten days, or whatever it was, I forget now. A few days in there. How many are going to believe today? How many will believe today if it repeats? See, there it is.

[73-4] At the end of the third day, He appeared and showed all of them His resurrection sign, that He was living, the same yesterday, today, and forever, Living fruit of His Presence. Living fruits of His Presence [are you getting it?] were manifested at the very end of the day when He appeared to all of them, His Church. Why? They'd all come together. Amen! At the end of the third day.

42 [73-5] The evening Lights, the Bible said, would shine in the last day. The same evening Light... Light in the West, the same One that shone in the East. [It has to be.] the same Light that shone in the East, that brought forth the first Church, that the Romans cut down by their pagan worship, and so forth; in the evening Light is the same Light.

It's got to be. You can't have two, three gods. You can't have two or three Jesus'. You can't have two or three spirits. You can't have two or three words. You got to go back to what it was. God Himself appeared to Paul. There's no two ways about it, out there in the desert with Jehovah.

Absolutely vindicated, absolutely revealed Jesus the Christ to him. Showed him the whole truth of the Resurrection. By revelation he understood communion, the Lord's supper, foot-washing, all of those things, just... nobody told him; God told him. Came back and established the church.

Do you think that anybody would listen to that man unless he was predestinated? Or do you think anyone would listen unless Paul had some kind of vindication?

43 Now I realise that the Mormons believe Joe Smith. I don't care what they believe. I've lived amongst them. I know what they got. I've lived amongst a lot of people. We were part Reform, we were part Catholic out of our family. I've been in Pentecost, with Baptist, the whole bunch.

It's fine, I have no problem with those people; they have what they have. But let me tell you one thing. At least those people stuck with the Word, the best they could and they knew that there wouldn't be a prophet like Joe Smith going to do anything for them because the man merely came back and said, "I saw, I say this, I say that." Buddha does the same thing. Confucius the same thing. The Taoists are in the same group. The Muslims are in the same bunch.

And you know the name 'Allah' is not the name of God; it's the god of the devil. We don't stand with that; we claim we believe this Bible written by prophets and if God sends a prophet, just like wrote this Bible, the people turn on him.

Now the question is this, "If they do, do they not crucify to themselves the Son of God

afresh and put him to an open shame?" That's the question I'm looking at this morning. The question I can answer in my own heart, this is exactly what has been done and they're going to be doing it.

44 Now Brother Branham goes on, he said, *"It's the same Light."*

[74-1] And what's the evening Light come out for? What is the evening Light for? To restore! You get it? The evening Light is for the same purpose the morning Light was for; to restore what was cut down by the Dark Ages through Rome, God is going to restore by shining forth in the evening Light.

Now Brother Branham is giving an illustration here which is literally a parable. And you can follow through by your history.

What? Restore the whole Word of God again, the full manifestation of Christ in His Church. Everything that He did, just exactly the way He did, would be again in the evening Light. See what I mean? Oh isn't it wonderful? And to know we're living right here to see It.

45 Now, listen, Brother Branham is not saying, now listen, Bride Church, you are all going to raise the dead. He said, *"Everybody does not pray for the sick."* There isn't one of us that is a 'jack-of-all-trades and a master of none' or that we are accomplished in every single thing in the ministry and out of the ministry.

For instance, gifts of the Spirit should never be in the church on the floor; that's where the Word is preached. It's out there in a little room, somewhere where they get together or someone has a spirit of discernment to know what is of God or of the devil.

Or that person has a reality and then it's all checked out before it even comes to the people: the Church under divine order. Brother Branham did not preach for one minute, that everyone in the church as the whole would have this. He said, *"If my hand does it; my body has done it."*

And if a prophet comes on the scene and brings forth those same manifestations that were in Christ because God is doing it, then the church has done it, because that prophet absolutely the Scripture said the church is built upon the apostles and the prophets.

So where do you get back? How do you get to understand there's a Capstone the same as the Cornerstone? How do you know it is the Capstone, if it doesn't repeat perfectly what was in the Cornerstone?

46 I hope I'm not preaching over your heads. To me it is so simple.

[74-2] Now, the evening Light [exactly according to prophecy], the evening Light came... to restore what? To restore what the bugs had eaten up.

[One:] It started growing, and then what'd it do? It denominated, so God pruned it off, bound them up, laid them back, let them go ahead and organise.

[Two:] *the next one came up; bound them, laid them off,* [the Tree, he just has to cut... lop the branches off.]

Now in the last days the organisations are going to be all bound together and burned. Now that's exactly true. The tares must all come together. Now let's look at the picture very closely.

When you look at tares, you have many similitudes in the Scripture that begin to tell you the truth. Jesus gave a parable; he said, "There's a certain man, a farmer, he sowed good seed, everybody knew it, and then a few days later, here's a bunch of tares. 'Well,' he said, 'an enemy did this.'"

47 Now, in Matthew he said, "Now beware of false shepherds, prophets who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly they are ravening wolves." They got all the trappings of a Christian. They got all the love. They got all the sweet talk. They've got all the nice deeds.

They got all the happy thinking, everything is right there, but they're off the Word. They're the tares. He said on that day of judgement; they'll come, "Lord, did we not cast out devils. Did we not do so and so?" "I never knew you."

And those that go with them. "I never knew you, depart from me to everlasting fire." And what does He say about the tares? "The tares," he said, "they're bound and they're burned." And what does he say about the chaff? And the chaff is the last thing that the wheat is in.

It looks identical to wheat until the drying season comes on, then the chaff pulls away and it's burned. Every time you see a burning, you have to understand it's the very same person or thing he's talking about and you cannot talk of fire until the end time. Every time you see that word, you know it's got to be Resurrection.

You know there's got to be Great Tribulation. You know there's going to be a Millennium. Listen, there's things in the Bible that you simply cannot ignore and just run and say, "Well, isn't this nice. Well, this says so and so." You got a hodge-podge or I have a hodge-podge; it is certainly true.

48 Now he says,

[74-3] But what then? Right on the top of the Tree is where the fruit ripens first, Why? [Because that's where the sun hits it. See? Right on the top.] right in the top of the Tree. So it's the top of the Tree where the evening Light begins to shine.

[74-4] Now, listen! Noah had three rooms in his ark. One room was for the creeping things. The second room was for fowls; and on the top room there was light that's where the light was. The light that shined first. It never came on the first floor, never came on the second floor, but on the top floor.

[See, at the end of the church and the top is the very top, that's the end of the building.] *The tree doesn't bear its fruit first,* [that's Luther, in the bottom or the] *second,* [that's Wesley] *like that, it's all pruned off in organisations.*

Wesley himself knew what was going to happen to the Methodists. He said, he said, "I do not fear for one minute, the name... the Methodist will cease from this earth, but I fear lest the spirit of God like a dove fly away." Wesley himself knew it. These men looked for the Pillar of Fire, don't you worry. They looked for the Pillar of Fire.

[74-4] [The first Tree didn't, the second Tree didn't]... all pruned off in organisations. But it's in the top part where "I will restore, saith the Lord. I'll send forth the evening Light, and It'll bring back the Word, making It manifest. I will restore all that I've promised. All that I've promised, the same Holy Spirit will bring and bear the same signs. I have an Easter, resurrection, for the Bride, the same that I as I had for the Bridegroom."

49 Let's go to 1 John, 1st verse,



1 John 3:1

(01) Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew [not him.]

Now look it right there. There's no recognition in you being an absolute true child of God. "Well, I can tell by that man's love. I can tell by his acts. I can tell by his spirit." You can't do it and you are lying to yourself, because Jesus had all of that. He raised the dead, he healed the sick, he fed the multitude, and they said, "We're going to kill you."

And he said, "What for? What evil have I done?" "Oh, ho, ho, nothing evil, dear boy, it's what you said."

You believe that? You can't be sitting here this morning in your right mind and not know I'm telling you the truth. They killed him for what he said.

So let's be honest; how can you tell... how does this same man John tell you that you're a son of God or not? He tells you, if you say the same thing as He does, you're of God and if you don't, you're not of God. Didn't say one thing on how he acted.

50 Paul the apostle said, "Let love be without dissimulation." You can take everyone of the nine fruits of the spirit and every one of the nine gifts so they're completely genuine and given by God; they can be in a phoney just like Judas who went out and healed the sick and raised the dead because he was one of the twelve that did it. Come on.

It's in the Bible. And he was an actual devil. "You're diabolos," Jesus said. He did it and you can take all the nine fruits and you can be hypocrite because Paul said and you know the big fruit is love and everything they tell you, every ordained preacher, every organised preacher, especially every Full Gospel, every fundamental, will tell you the word 'love' contains all of those other eight gifts and Paul said, "Let love be without hypocrisy."

Have a hypocrite, or what? Yeah, same as a man that seduces a woman and destroys her life.

51 Let's keep reading.



1 John 3:1-2

- (01) ...the world knoweth us not, [They didn't know Jesus, not going to know you.]
- (02) Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear [it says, it never come into existence] what we shall be: but [listen!] but we know... when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

How many people read that right? I'll tell you how they read it: they say, bless God, there's going to be a Rapture; I'm going to be changed, just like Him and I'm going to be caught up to see Him. My Bible doesn't say that. My Bible says you got to see him, then you get your change.

I've read my Bible. I've got thirty-two translations in my office strung around the house, thirty-two or better, unless I threw some away. I check all these verses out to see what all thirty-two people say, maybe dozens more. They never say one thing different than I've caught; it's all the same story amongst the fundamentals, "Bless God, I'm going to be changed and I'll be caught up to see Him."

My Bible says, "You are going to see Him here first before you ever get your change." Now how are you going to see Him? That's the point. Jesus said, "He that hath seen Me hath seen the Father." What was it? It wasn't his figure, no, it wasn't his figure. It was the works.

And the works always lead in a prophet to vindication so the people know his word is from God. Will it come again in this hour? I believe with all my heart, it's already come. I'm not trying to convince you.

52 I was accused years ago by a very nice man, he and I didn't agree, he said, "The trouble with you, Vayle, you made an overkill." I never make an overkill.

I can sit here hour after hour and hit Scripture after Scripture, send these tapes around the world, tape after tape, and they'll still come back and say, "Lee Vayle is preaching two gods." Though I read exactly what I read here this morning.

I've made statements and cleared myself from one end to the other; and here a woman leave the church and phone her pastor say, "Why did Brother Vayle say so and so? He said, "My sister, he didn't: what were you listening to?"

I'm not on overkill this morning with emphasis or anything else, I'm just trying to get you to understand what's in my heart, what I believe to be the truth by vindication. And if I am right, then I'm free from the blood of all men.

I can meet any of you at the White Throne or in hell, anyplace else, and I'm free, if I'm right. Now, if I taught you wrong, I'm wrong and you're wrong, I got to answer to God. I don't have to answer to God for all your sins and all, mind you, I'm going to answer to God for leading you. Now frankly I don't lead anybody. I trust not. I trust the Word of God leads us all. See?

53 [74-3] [What then?] Right in the top of the Tree is where the fruit ripens first [that's right], right in the top of the Tree. It's at the top of the Tree here we see the evening Light.

Now listen, what is ripe fruit? At the top of the Tree. At the end of time, there's a ripened fruit. Now what is the ripened fruit? What did Adam want? What was his? Immortality. When God was there in the form of the Holy Spirit which He is anyway, giving him His Word,

the Holy Spirit leading him and the animals. God in control through a man and the woman came by and enticed him and he went away. And Adam could not get to the Tree.

So what are we looking at? We are looking at the fact that the ripened fruit that should have been there, the interruption, now six thousand years later. There is that manifestation where people stand in the Presence of God Himself, the Holy Ghost in the Pillar of Fire completely manifested, proving that it is God, it's time for a Resurrection.

It's time to go to the Tree of Life. It's time for immortality, for the evening Light has come. Certainly, it was morning light over there in the East, but in the West—and the Bible tells you that—it's the light that travelled, it's the light that is here.

The evening Light came. The same light that shone in the morning, the same sign, the same light will produce the same fruit that it had there, if it's shining in the same Tree, Bride Tree. Amen. Proves His Word is now fulfilled.

⁵⁴ "I will restore, saith the Lord. The Light shone for the Bride, not the prophet. William Branham did not have a sign for himself, he did not have a gift for himself, and let me tell you, the same Word that came to William Branham, he had to live by the same Word he gave to us. The same as that manna that Moses prayed for, for Israel, and God sent down.

Moses ate the same manna the people ate. And I want to tell you something; the manna was not a crude tasteless dish to Moses and to Caleb and to Joshua and those predestinated true men of God. It tasted rich, sweet, marvellous substance. They say it was like coriander. "I can't stand coriander."

Hey, I want to tell you something; I don't care what this Word tastes like. I want It because I know it is good for me, it is ripe for me, and one day I will love It and I do love It with all of my heart. I'm looking at It today. It was not for the prophet, this Light fell on the Bride and it took a prophet as Brother Branham said to do it.

Now remember, Brother Branham does not take any pleasure to himself, he doesn't take any authority, he said, *"Listen, I want to tell you something; our Elijah today is the Lord Jesus Christ, Himself, not a man, God, but it comes by a prophet."* And you show me any Word, brother/sister that does not come by a prophet.

55 Now let's look at these things, John was not a prophet: no dice. He was a scribe, he wrote. He wrote even the Book of Revelations, strictly from visions, again as a scribe. Paul was the prophet. Come on, Peter wasn't.

Peter could tell you things, absolutely, he knew from the Word but Christ said, "Word being fulfilled," but Peter, although agreeing and understanding with Paul, he was not the one to whom the revelation came.

Now let's go back, can we get restored, the right Jesus, the right Word, the right Spirit? You

tell me. So, Brother Vayle, it's logical, it's easy to see, it would take a man like Paul. That's exactly right. I believe we've seen it. I believe in our hour and our day this has come to pass.

56 Well, the Lord bless you. My time always runs out and I guess that's too good because we all get tired, we need refreshing, sometimes we hear too much, hard to assimilate, I myself will admit to you without a wink of an eye, that sometimes I have to pinch myself to remember many of the things that I get from the Word here, go back and forth as Brother Branham taught us through the Bible.

And I will go even further, that you may be really surprised. I have said things that I absolutely forgot and somebody reminded me, but you're no different. You're no different.

So, if you forget something, we've got a faithful God who brings those things to our remembrance, what we have need of; He supplies our need, our life and breath are in Him, everything is in Him, and I believe brother/sister, that we are at the end time. Israel is in the homeland.

Sign of the Resurrection. Something has got to happen to get this Bride out of here, and I believe with all my heart there is a Bride and I say with Brother Branham the truth and I say it more truthfully I believe as the days go by, when he said, *"If we're not Bride, there's a Bride out there somewhere and by the grace of God, I won't stand in her way."*

In other words, I won't do one thing that will take away from her what she believes she's got or she has got. I'll just stand back and watch, but I won't lay a finger on her.

57 I believe what I'm preaching this morning from Brother Branham's Message. I believe that God did plant that Tree. I believe we are God's husbandry. I believe we're God's edifice and as that edifice got to go right to the top where the Capstone fits on; I believe it's right there, just like the pyramid.

Capstone to fit on; I have no doubt about that in my heart and mind, we're there. The same with the Tree; I believe the evening Light has come. I believe the fruit is ripe. I believe God is here in the form of the Holy Spirit, not as the Baptiser.

Now, though He is the Baptiser, but He Himself the Baptiser, heading His own Church. His voice will soon bring the dead out of the ground. We'll be changed, the Bible says. I believe there's going to be a Bride get out of here. I hope by the grace of God I'm one. I cannot boast that I am, all I can do is believe and that's all you can do.

58 You say, "I've seen by your actions, Brother Vayle, that doesn't mean one thing." Take me back to the Word: where am I off the Word? I can take David right back to the Word: why did he even look at that woman? The minute you saw her naked, why didn't you change and take your eyeballs off of her and go to your room? He sinned right there.

He coveted another man's wife. He sinned right there. But I'm going to tell you; show me where David was off the Word. I can show you conduct; show me Word. Let me say again what I said at a funeral and I mean it, because this could be a funeral, too, today. No man ever lived the Word, outside of Jesus Christ and no man ever will, but we can believe It.

Let's rise and be dismissed.



Heavenly Father, again we thank You for grace which has been given unto us, and we believe Lord, that this is a manifestation of Your love. And if we believe this Word in Your heart then we believe also it is a manifestation of love of God in our hearts shed abroad there by the Holy Ghost, which Lord, would tend first of all,

So, Lord, we stand here this morning and we admit Father, that as just like a person, just like Brother Branham described Adam there, he could have stood there in flesh with his toes into the ground like roots of a tree and then God breathed into him the breath of life.

The man not just stood any longer began to pulsate and move, a glorious creature of God. So breathe on us today, Lord, that's what we're asking by the Holy Spirit. Breathe on us, Lord that we might understand more of the light and that which is come in this hour.

And we pray Lord, that You heal the sick amongst us, people are still sick, little children particularly. We ask You Lord, that You heal the people here and help them in whatever they have need of, we know that those needs are met.

Father, it's wonderful to testify how that You do so wonderful things for us, You help us, You keep us in all these ways and we're grateful for it Lord, but above all we're grateful for the grace given unto us whereby we believe we can be in. And certainly Lord, we do believe with all of our hearts as much as we can believe that we're a part of those ones that are going into the Rapture.

May grace and peace be multiplied to every single person here, not one person leave an unbeliever in You Lord, unbelieving in the truth of the great God who is reigning and ruling in this universe and one day will take over and make His own, may there not be one of us missing in the Holy City or outside to bring our glory in, and we give You the praise in Jesus' Name,
